Primary Function/Purpose

Instructors in the Graduate Counseling Department collaborate to deliver excellent education and field experiences for residential and online students at Clarks Summit University.

Primary Duties

1. Teach and develop Counseling courses
2. Serve as a Core Faculty Member for the Master of Science in Counseling program
 - a. Provide leadership and direction to the program
 - b. Set budgetary priorities for the program
 - c. Assess the program
 - d. Advise students
3. Travel to campus 3 times a year for module courses or meetings as determine by program leadership

Secondary Duties

1. Mentor and counsel students
2. Respond to program inquiries
3. Fulfill faculty responsibilities as determined by the administration
4. Attend professional conferences annually

Qualifications

1. Terminal degree in Counselor Education or a related field (must meet CACREP degree requirements)
2. Biblical philosophy of counseling
3. Appropriate state and national credentials, and membership in counseling associations
4. Evidence of professional development and renewal activities related to counseling, professional service and advocacy in counseling, and research and scholarly activity in counseling.
5. Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to effectively communicate with a wide range of individuals and constituencies in a diverse community
6. Strong computer skills to facilitate online education
7. Full agreement with the Statement of Faith and Standards of Conduct of Clarks Summit University
